

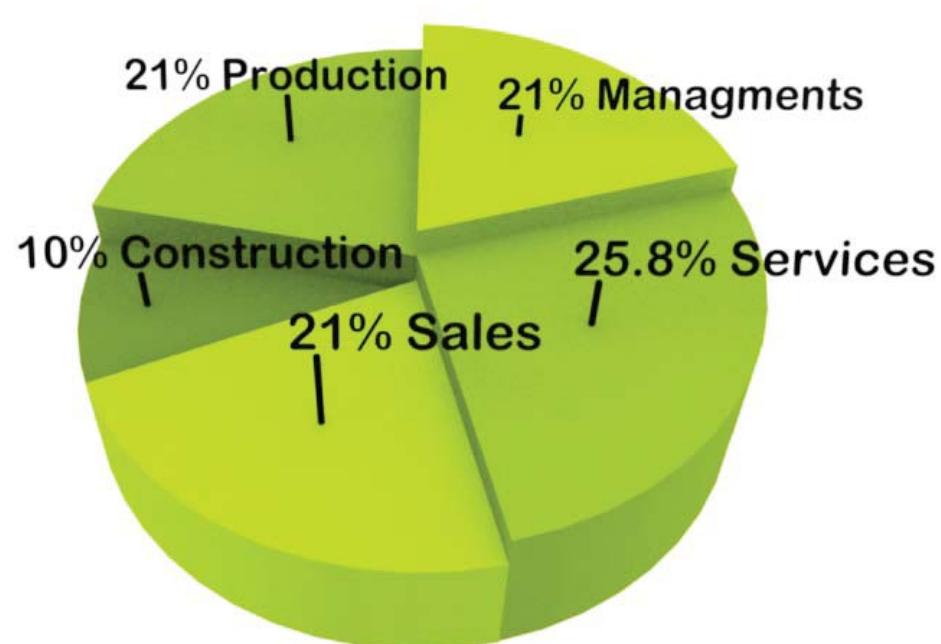
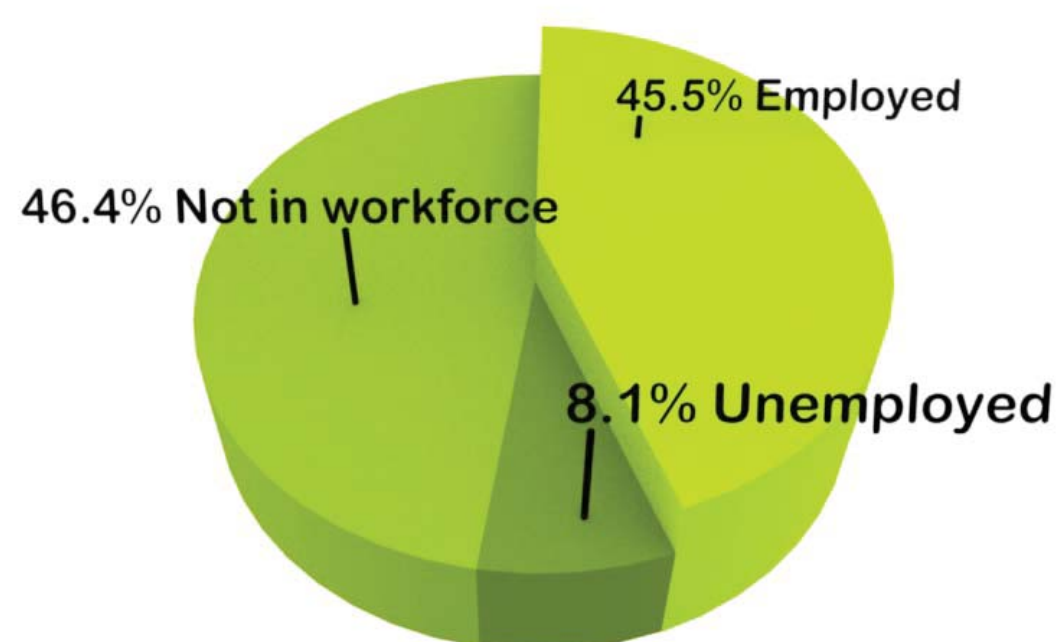

- Employment for the City of Osceola indicates that most people are employed out of town and requires commute to work.
- 46% of the able to work population is not employed and not seeking employment and unemployment is at 8.1%.
- The smallest portion of employment is in construction with only 10%, this includes transportation of material for construction related jobs and any other support jobs for the construction industry.

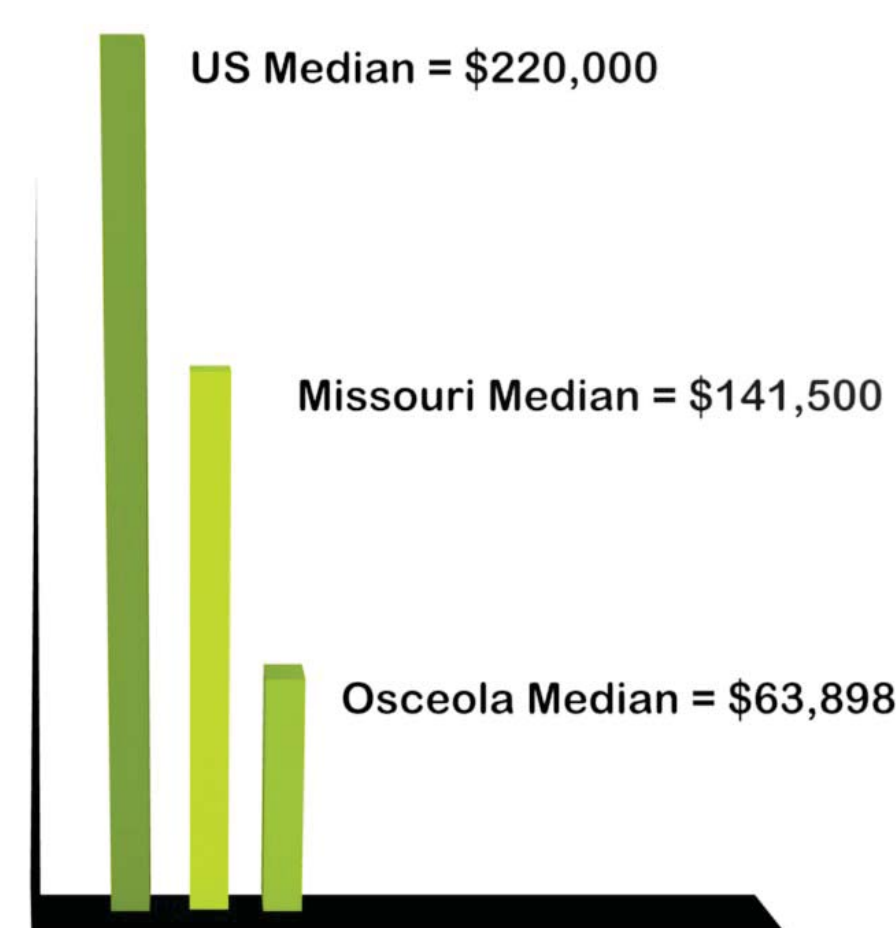
